



**Updated April 15, 2011**

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Riders and Staff are reporting FRESH SNOW ranging from 1' to over 2' in each of the riding areas. Conditions are exceptional for mid-April. All three areas are ready for the weekend ! Please understand that we are always doing the best we can with the trails in the current weather conditions.

Watch out for afternoon sun warming and please check the conditions for your area at [www.avalanche.ca](http://www.avalanche.ca) before heading out for your days ride.

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**Allan:** is still being maintained and will be groomed Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Wednesday evenings, barring unforeseen circumstances.

**Clemina:** Will be regroomed Friday April 15<sup>th</sup> from 3km. The trail from the parking area has good snow cover and is in good shape as of Friday morning and the area is good to go for the weekend

**Chappell Creek:** only twelve users in the area on Friday and VARDA staff reported over 2' of FRESH SNOW in the alpine. Conditions here are EPIC for april !

**Keyhole:** Logging is still going on this area and we are unable to groom. Please remember that it is illegal to operate a snowmobile on a plowed road. Radio contact is a must if you insist on driving up this road to the snowline.
