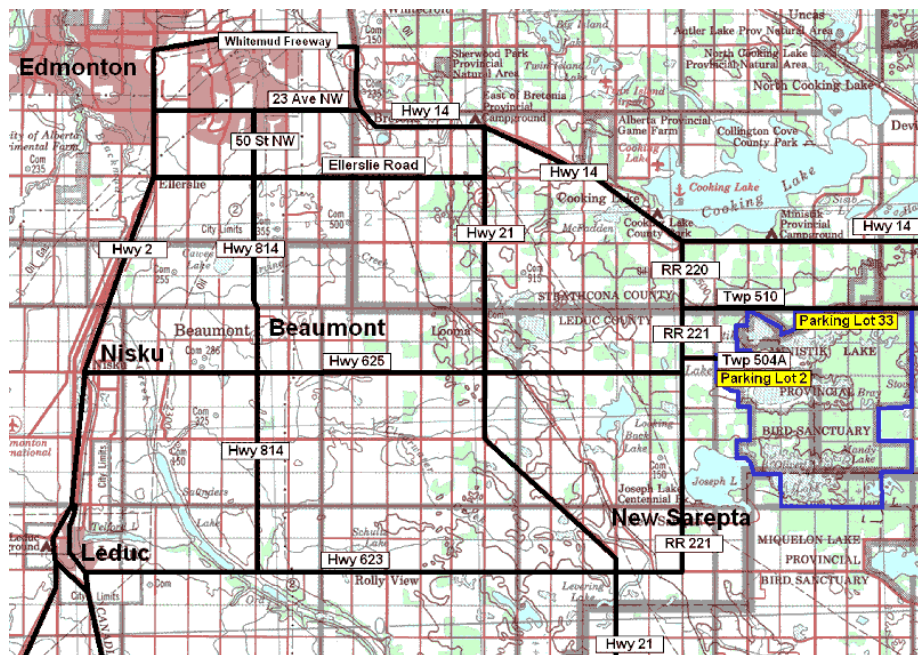
## Ministik Lake Trail Map

**GPS Waypoints:** Tri-County Snowmobile Club (TCSC) provides our members with the GPS waypoint information for our maps.

**Ministik Lake Trail System:** The trail system is part of the Ministik Lake Bird Sanctuary and available for snowmobile use only when specifically open (December 1 when there is at least 6" of snow cover to March 1). Please check the [www.tri-county.ab.ca](http://www.tri-county.ab.ca) website for trail status. Use of this system is only possible through the grace of the Ministik Lake Public Advisory Committee – please be respectful of our hosts and their environment! The Ministik Lake Trail System is maintained through a joint effort by Tri-County Snowmobile Club with funding from Alberta Snowmobile Association (ASA) trail development.

**Trail Passes:** Join our team by purchasing your ASA Trail Passes and TCSC Membership. - Take any freeway east in Edmonton until you reach 1st Street (Meridian Road).
- Turn to the right (south) on 1st Street (Meridian Road) and follow it until it turns east, which will now become Hwy 14 East.
- Travel east bound under the Camrose turn off (Hwy 21 overpass) and keep going to just past the Cooking Lake Sailing Club.
- Watch on the right side for the sign "Range Road 220 (RR220)" and turn right (south) down RR220 for about 3 KM.
- NOTE: When you meet Township Road 510 (Twp510 is a correction road, Range Roads south are 1 number greater than on the north side of the road see map).
- For Parking Lot **Access #33** (North Lot) turn left (east) when you hit the intersection of Twp 510 the correction road (the road is not straight it is 15 feet to the left). Keep going (East) about 5 Km, the parking lot is on the right side.
- For Parking Lot **Access #2** (West Lot) keep going straight ahead on RR221 past Twp 510 until you reach Twp 504A. Turn left (east) on Twp 504A and drive about 1.4km to the Ministik Lake Bird Sanctuary parking area Access #2, which is on the corner of Twp504A and RR220.
- **Access #22** on the east side has NO parking. It is only a trail exiting the Sanctuary onto a county road.
- The Sanctuary is about 8.5Km by 8.5Km square or about 75Km square of snowmobiling with about 60Km of marked trails.
- The trails range from lakes, meadows, bush, hills and creek beds.
- There are lots of Deer, Moose, coyotes and various range birds.
