HOLIDAY GROOMING SCHEDULE

Conditions in the alpine are improving quickly and all of the managed areas are holding good snow and the hazards are finally beginning to get buried, but they are still there, so ride with caution. The areas are screaming for some fresh snowfall for the holidays and the forecast look promising, although we have not seen it yet. The trails are in awesome shape and are being maintained regularly.

Allan Creek – Was last groomed on Wednesday Dec 22rd and will be regroomed Sunday Dec 26th and will continue to be maintained as needed throughout the holiday season.

Clemina Creek – Was last groomed on Wednesday Dec 22rd and will be regroomed Sunday Dec 26th and will continue to be maintained as needed throughout the holiday season. Please **DO NOT** ride on the Plowed road and stick to the paralleling groomed trail. It is **ILLEGAL** to operate a snowmobile on a plowed road.

Chappell Creek: Will be groomed Thursday December 23rd. Additional runs are possible throughout the holiday week.

Keyhole: There is logging in this area so the trail system is being plowed, radio contact is a must if you insist on driving up this road.

Trail passes will not be required for Saturday 25th and Sunday 26th.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, statements and dates may change !
