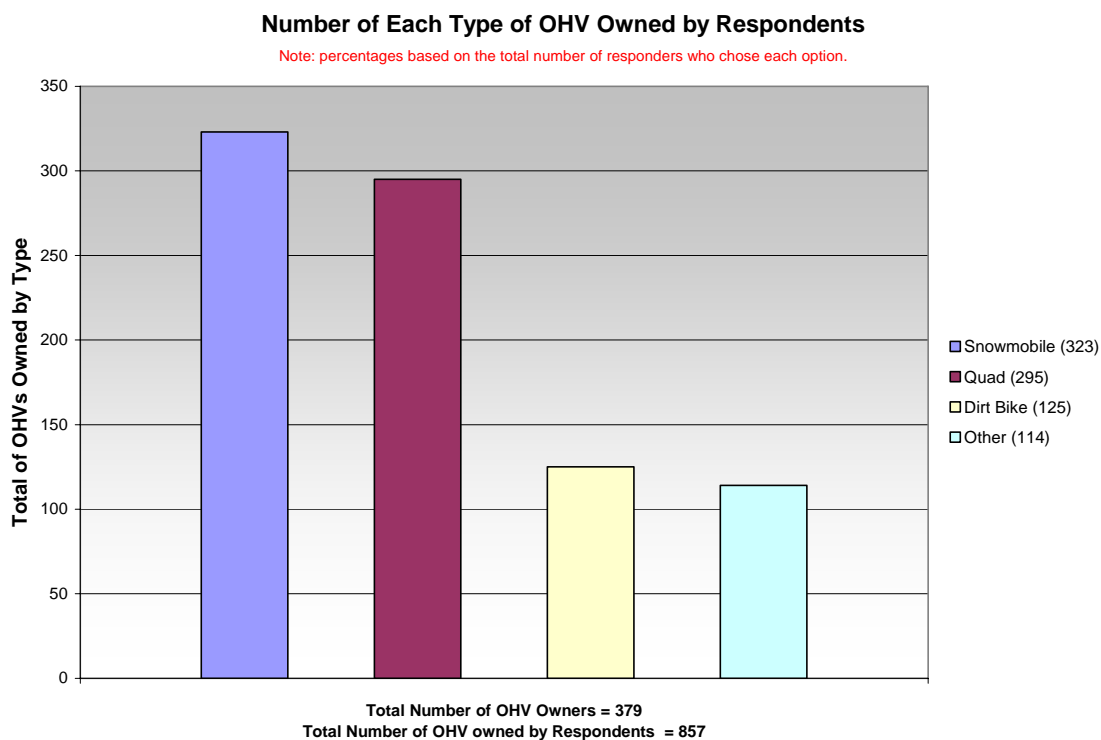

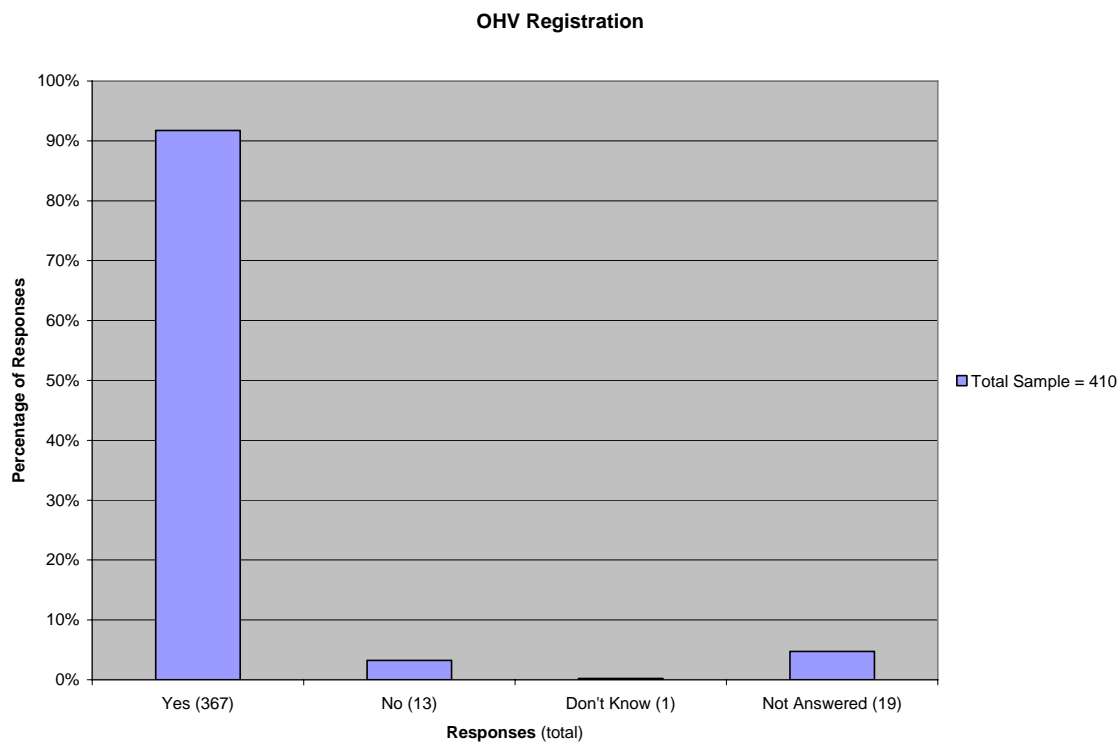
### Question 5 – If yes, how many of the following OHVs are in your household?



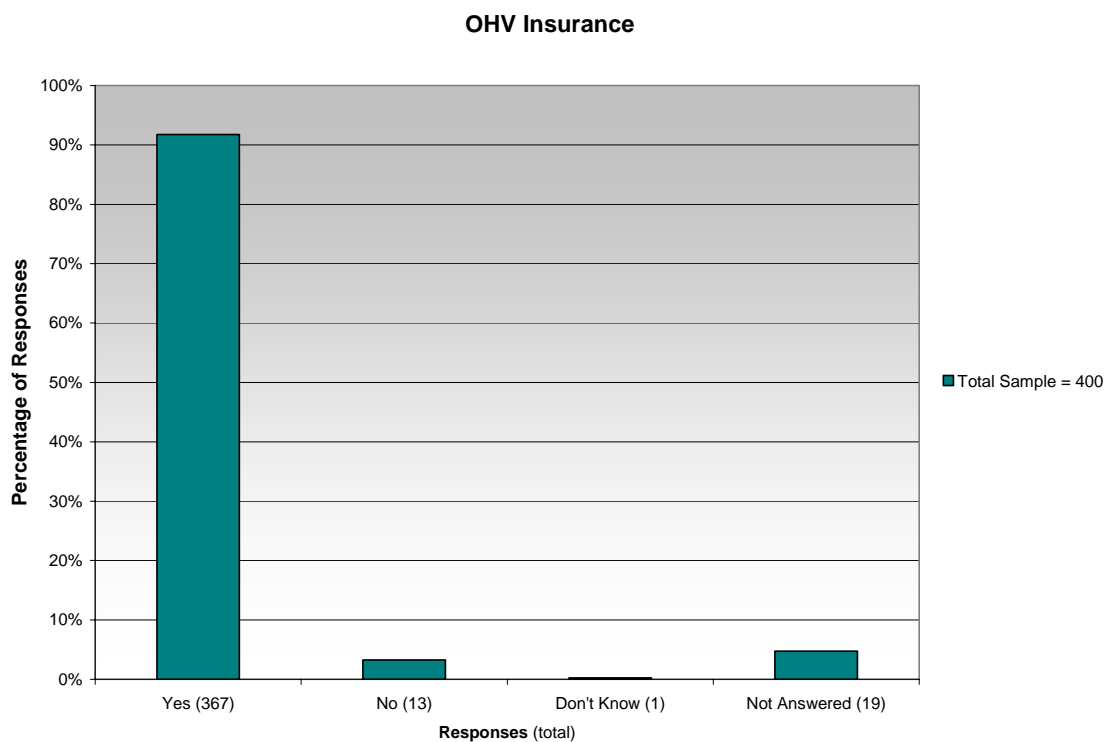

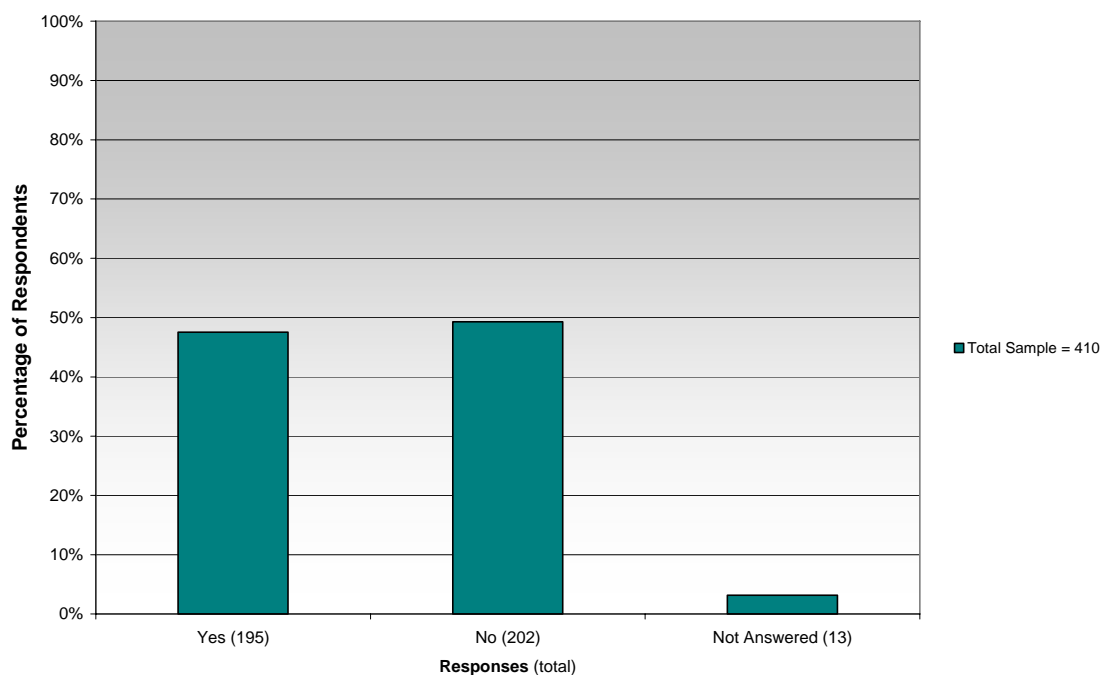

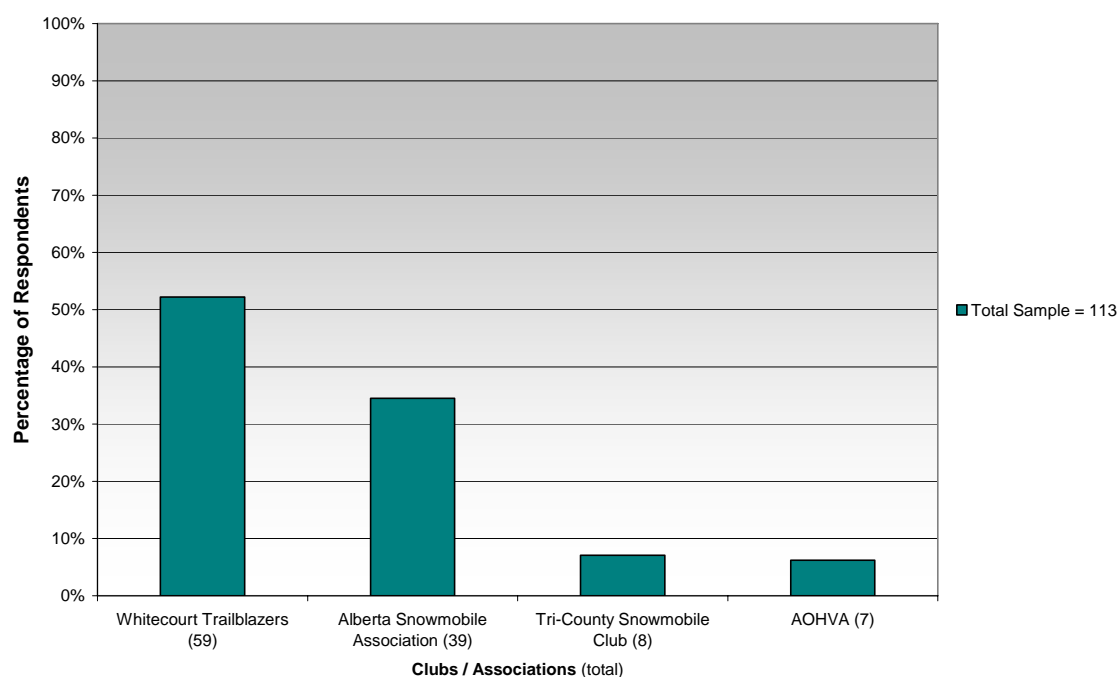

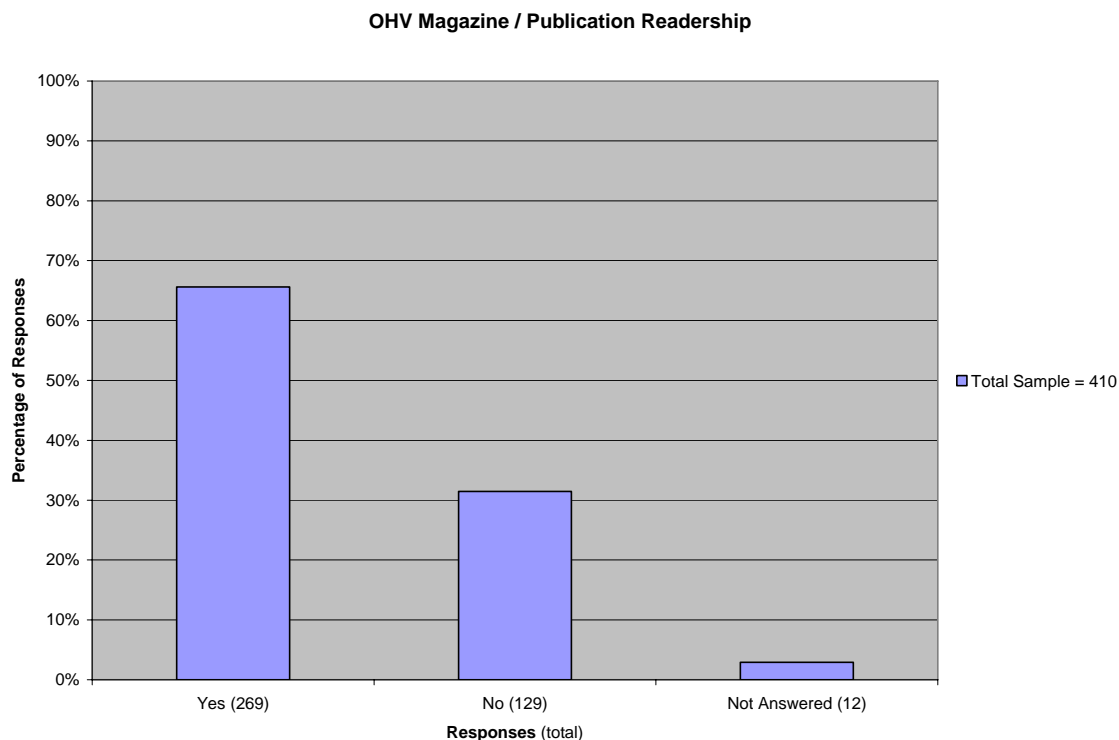

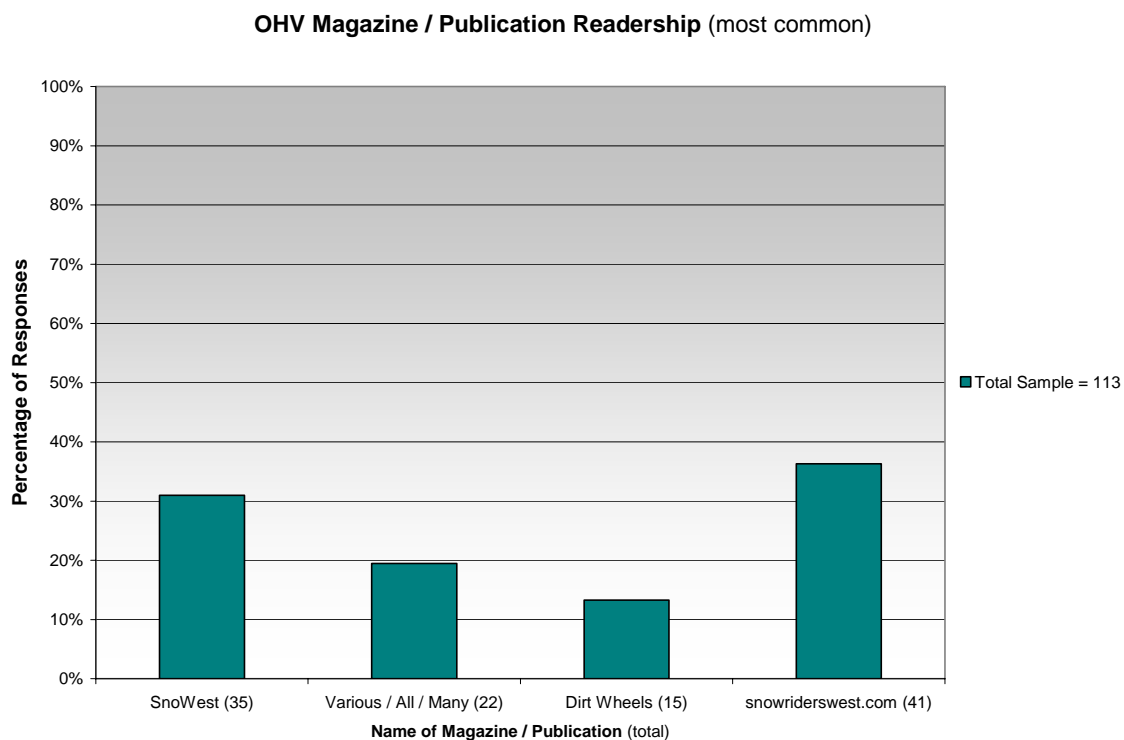

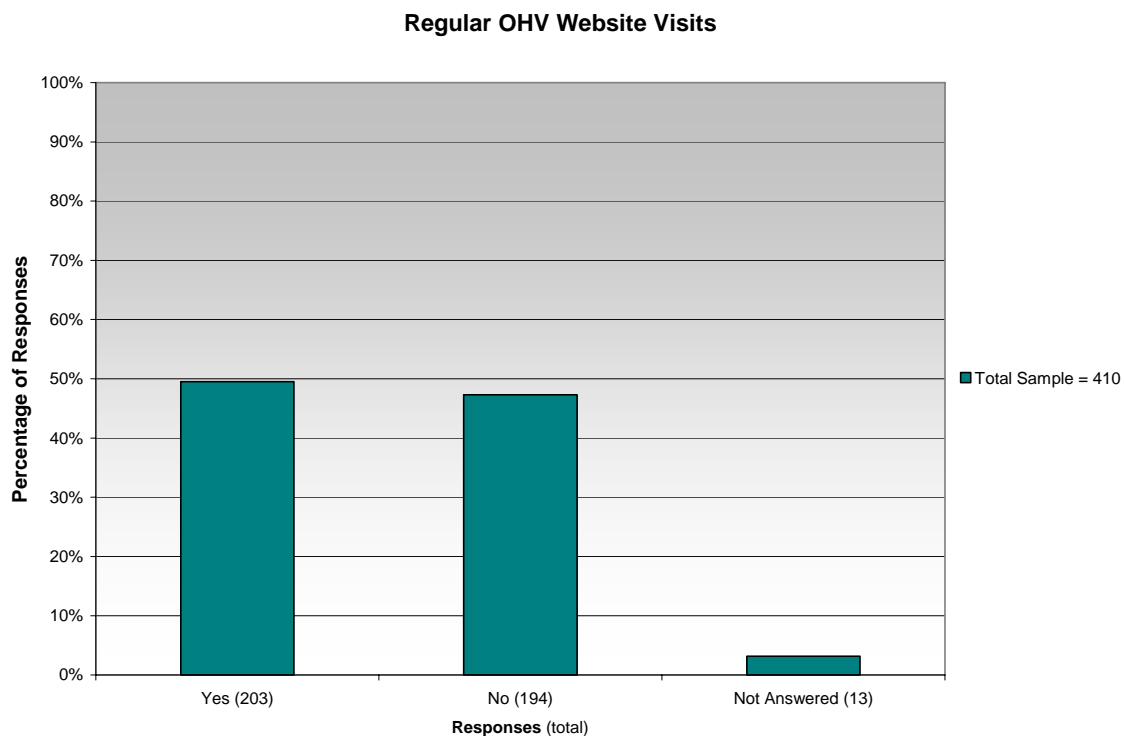

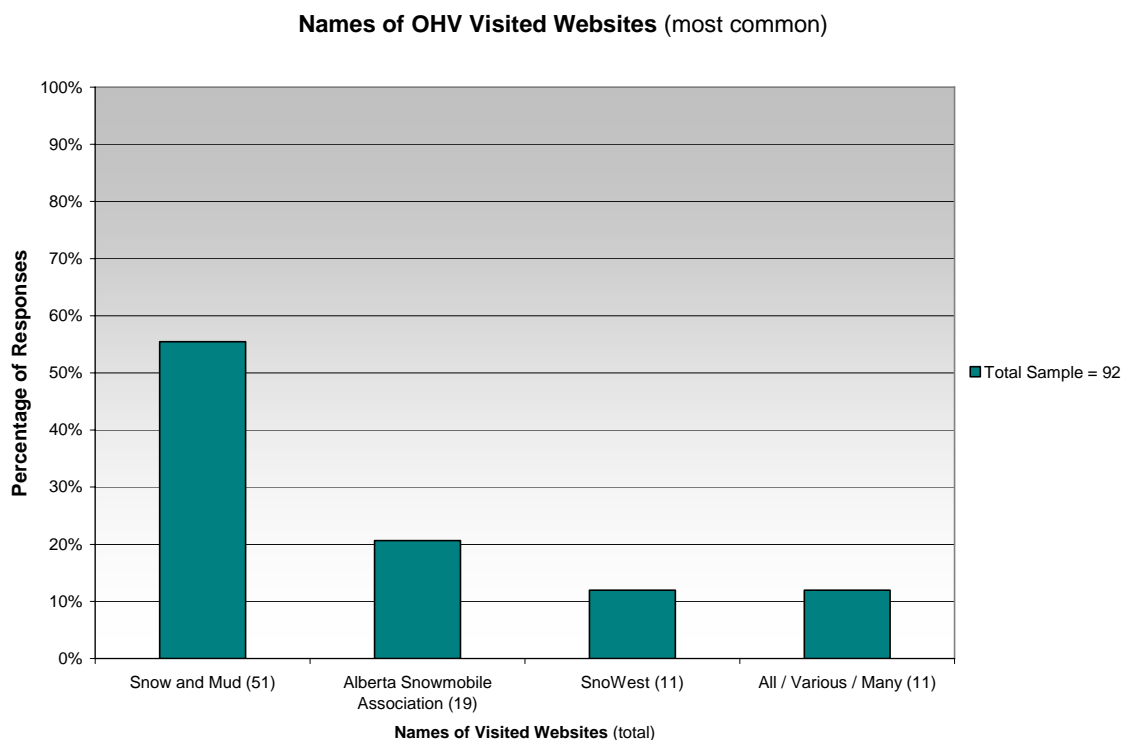

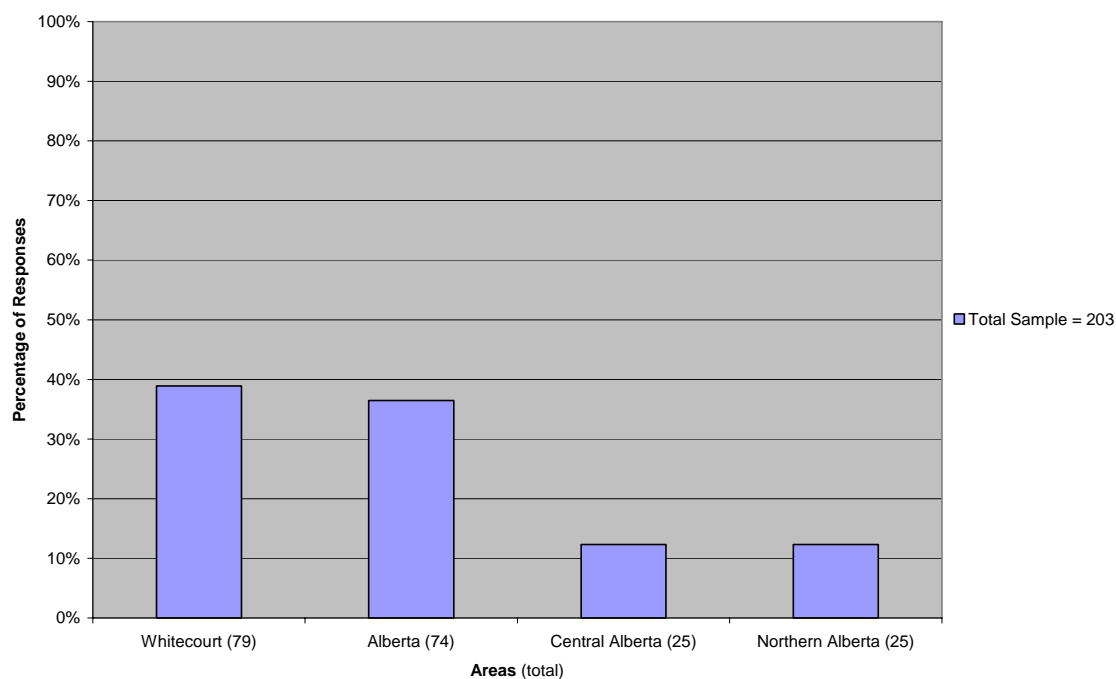

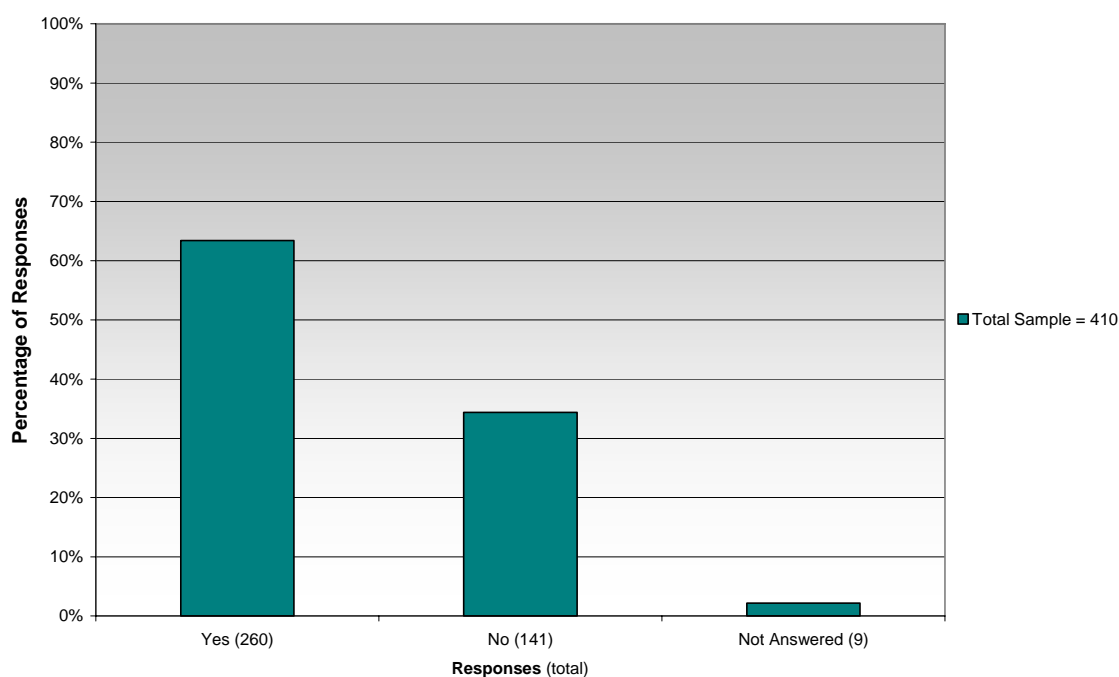
### Question 14 – In which areas of the province do you typically operate an OHV?

Respondents Who Operate on Designated Trail Systems



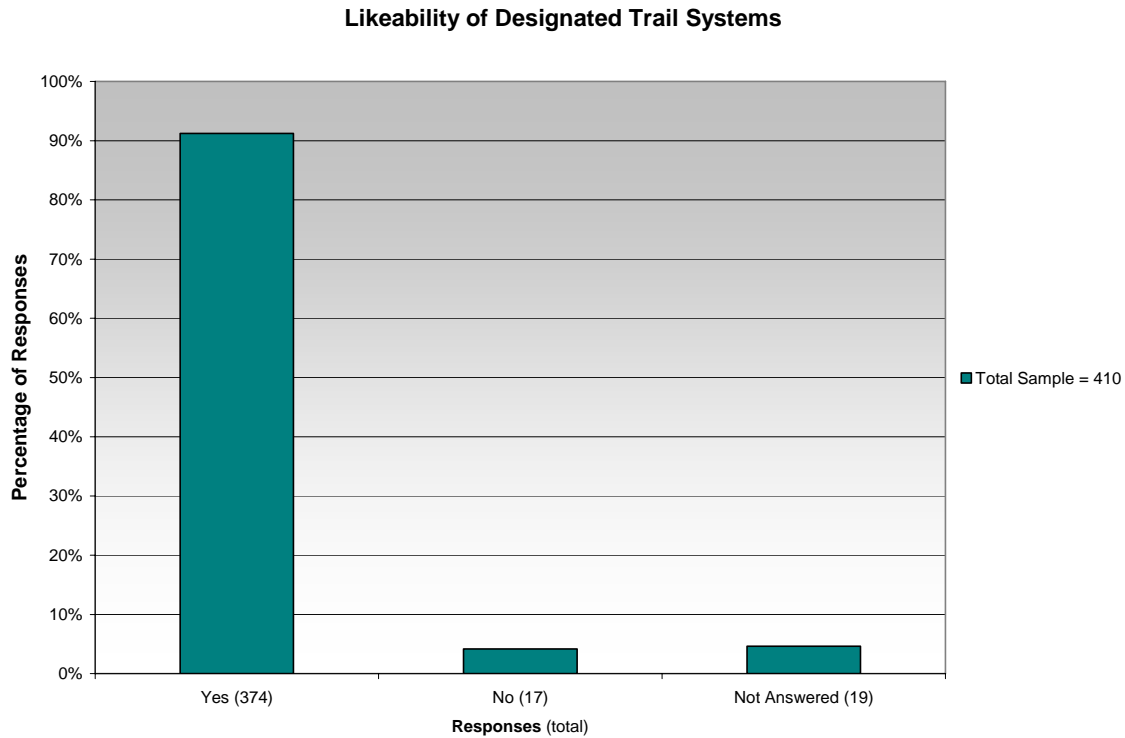

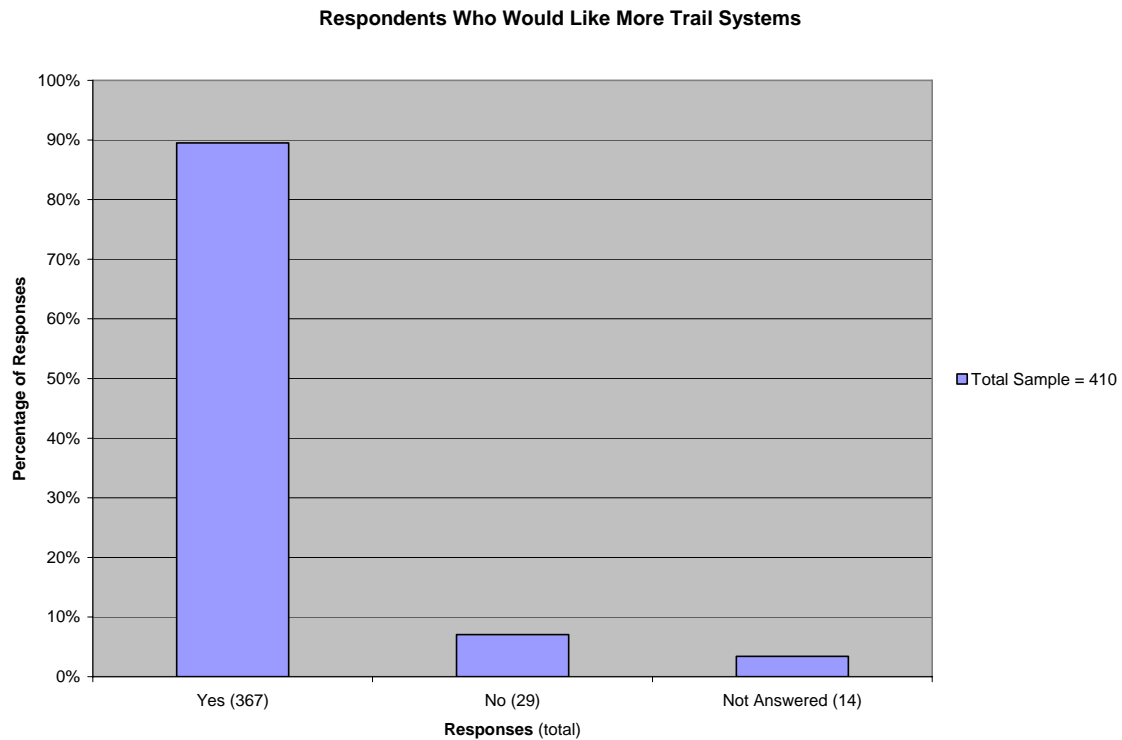

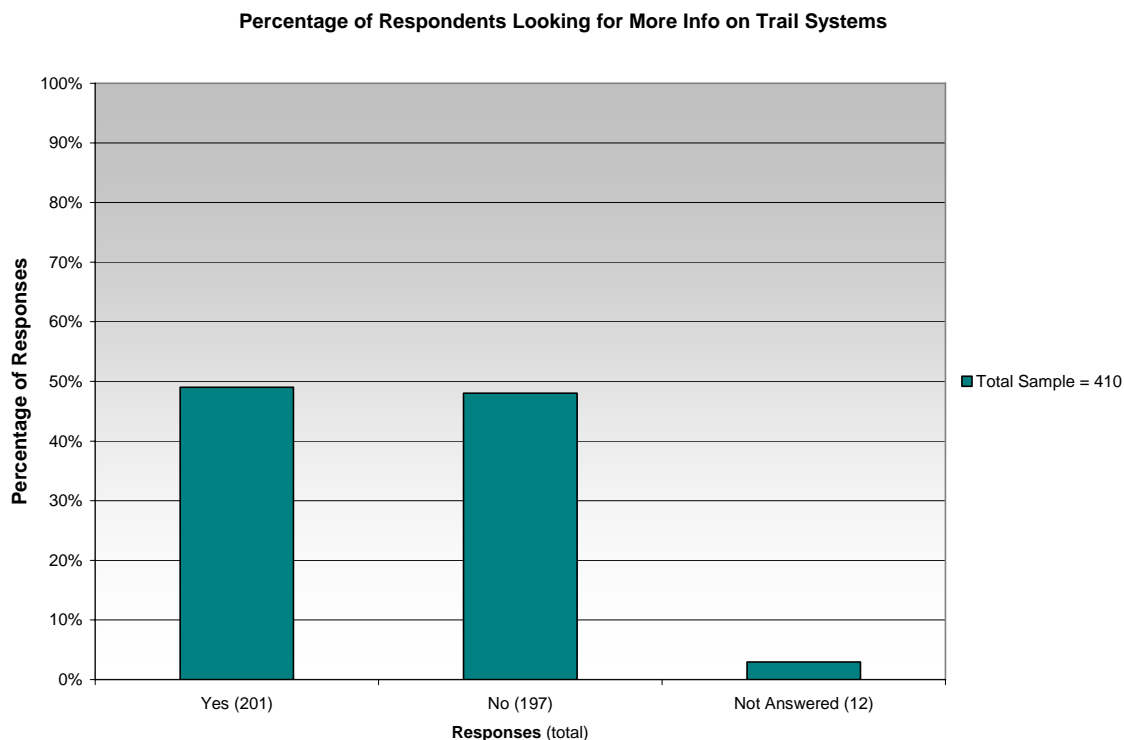

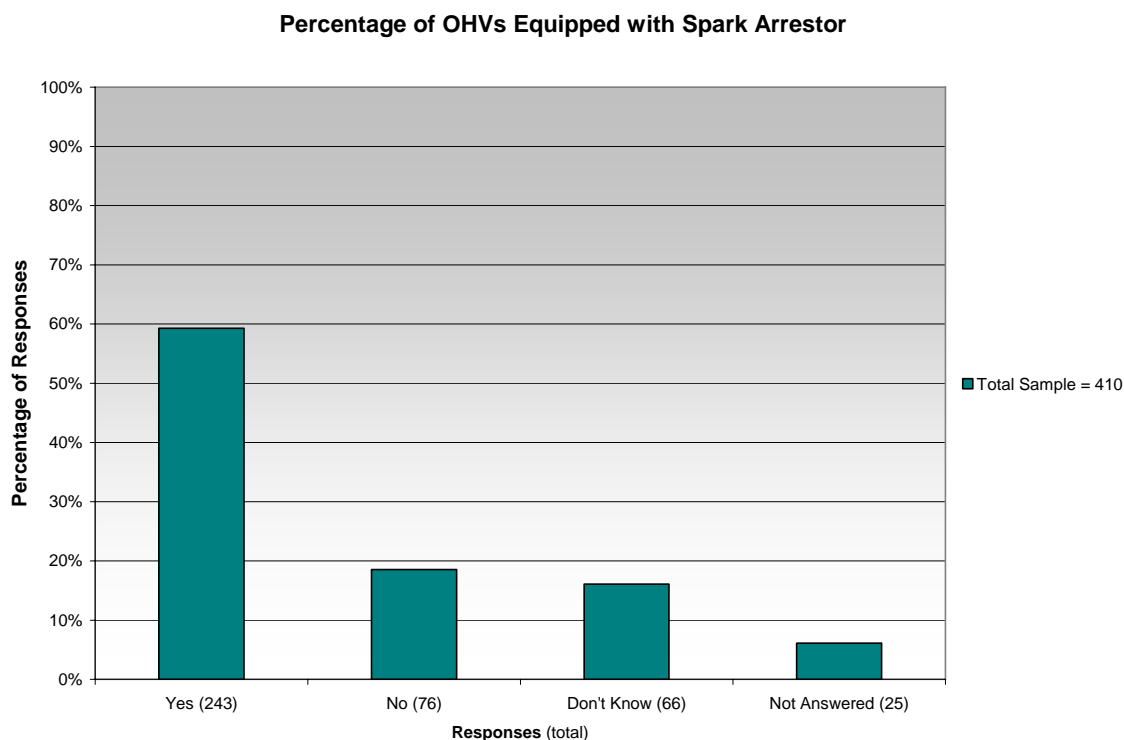

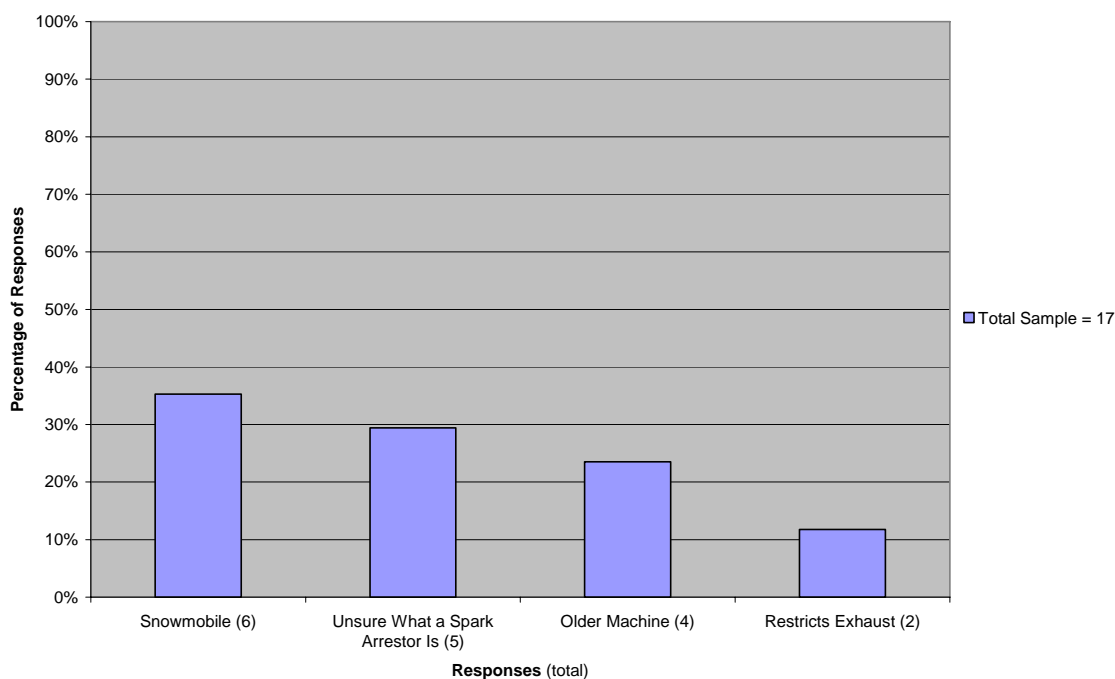

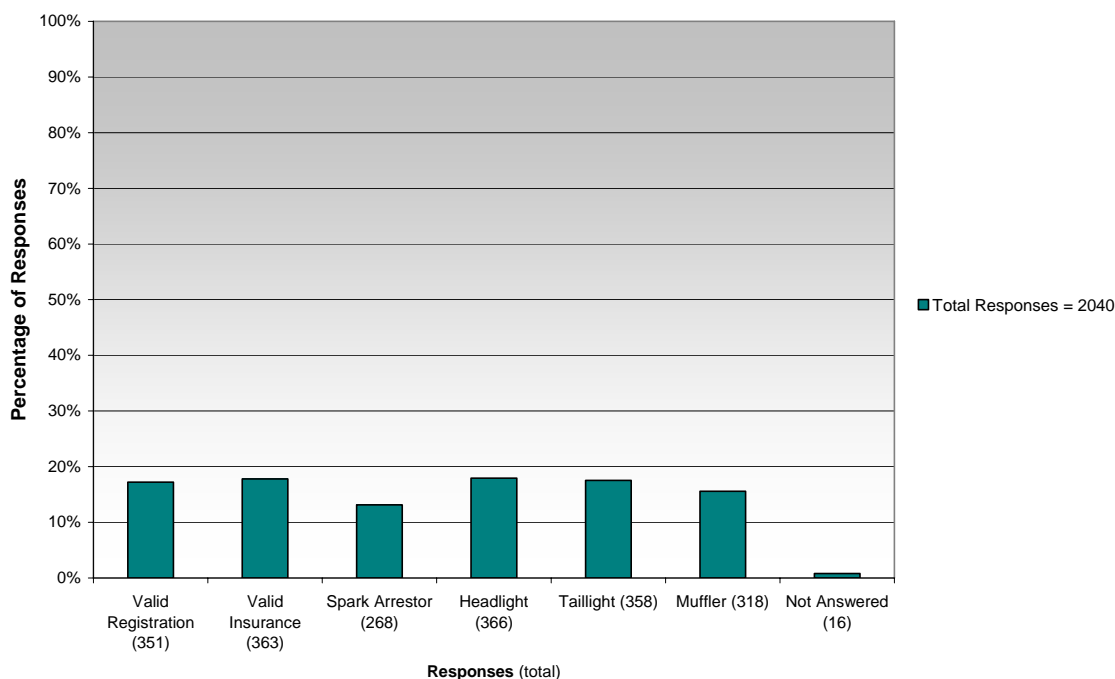
Reasoning for No Spark Arrestor (4 most common)

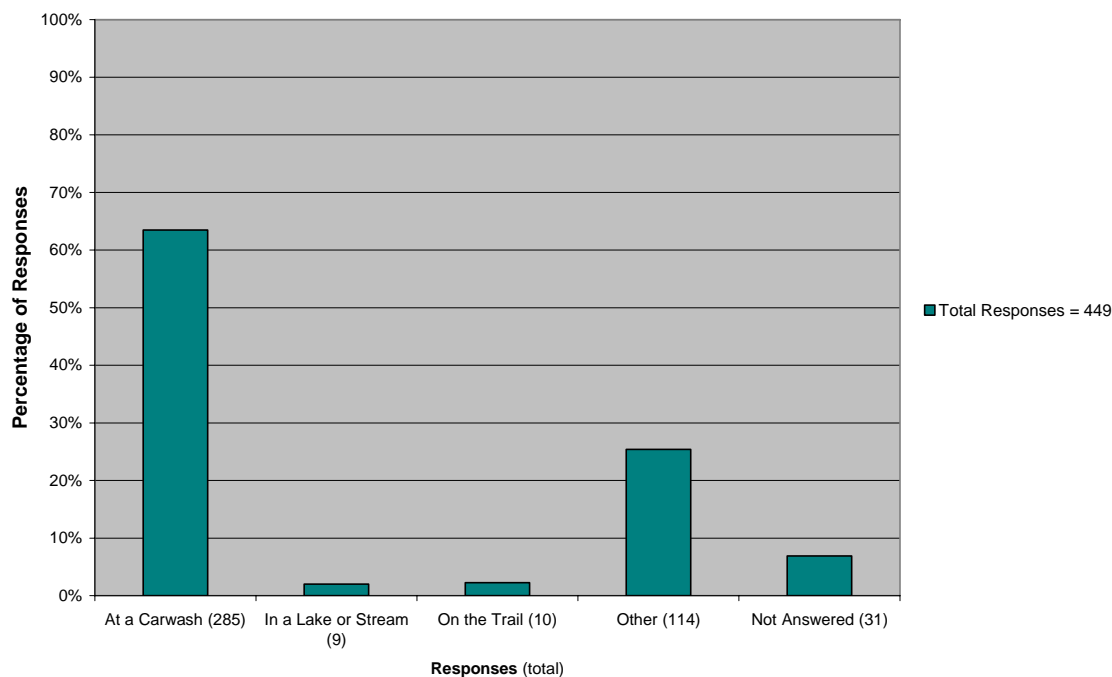
